The Sheboygan County Community Partnership for Children (SCCPC) is a cradle to career initiative focused on prevention and support for children, their families and caregivers.

PROGRAMS & ACTIVITIES

Welcome Baby Program

The Welcome Baby program is offered to all first-time parents in Sheboygan County. During the visit, a Resource Specialist meets with families in the hospitals to provide community resource information, as well as connect families to Parents as Teachers home visiting program.

Community Developmental Screens

Community developmental screening events give parents and caregivers another opportunity to discuss their child's development with trained staff who can share activities to foster healthy child development and connect families to community resources.

Parent Café Workshops

Parent Cafés explore the 5 Strengthening Families Protective Factors through guided peer-to-peer learning, self reflection and conversations that strengthen the social and emotional health of families.
