Are you a member of the LGBTQ+ community in need of the COVID-19 Vaccine?

How to get an appointment:

The Sheboygan County Division of Public Health can help you schedule an appointment. Please call the **COVID-19 Vaccine Hotline at 920-395-9890**. Leave a message and one of the patient advocates will call you back to help you schedule an appointment with a local provider. Everyone 16 years and older is eligible.

Why get vaccinated?

- Health disparities impact LGBTQ+ communities in many negative ways, especially related to safe access to care. This results in disproportionate rates of some health conditions and outcomes for LGBTQ+ people.
- COVID-19 has had a disproportionate impact on LGBTQ+ people, especially LGBTQ+BIPOC communities.
- The vaccines are a **safe** and important tool to protect all of us! And, the COVID-19 vaccine is **free**. **Call the Hotline today.**

It is important to acknowledge mistrust of the medical community held by many LGBTQ+ people, especially BIPOC, due to the extensive history of harm caused by the medical establishment. In acknowledgment of this mistrust, the Sheboygan County LGBTQ Alliance is partnering with the Sheboygan County Division of Public Health to provide clear, transparent, factual information about COVID-19 vaccinations to our community.
